Cairo and Cruise

Include:

- ⇒ 4 nights in Cairo with bed and breakfast
- ⇒ 4 nights on cruise with full board (no beverages)
- ⇒ Visit to the Pyramids, the Sphinx, Valley Temple (without entering any pyramid), Memphis and Saqqara. Lunch at a typical restaurant.
- ⇒ Visit of Cairo city including the Citadel of Saladin, the Antiquities Museum, Old Cairo (Coptic Museum not included), Khan El Khalili district. Lunch at a typical restaurant.
- ⇒ Cruise visits:
 - Luxor: Valley of the Kings, Colossi of Memnon, Karnak Temple, Luxor Temple
 - Edfu: Temple dedicated to the god Horus
 - Kom Ombo: Temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris
- ⇒ Aswan: Felucca ride around the islands of Aswan, High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk, and visit to Philae Temple
- ⇒ All transfers in air-conditioned vehicles
- ⇒ Spanish-speaking guide during all visits

During the Nile navigation, witness the impressive solar eclipse, a celestial spectacle visible from a sacred and historic location. A magical moment that will unite sky, Nile... and spirit.

Itinerario:

Day 1 – Cairo – 29/07/2027

Arrival at Cairo International Airport. Reception, assistance, and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation in Cairo.



Day 2 – Cairo (Breakfast / Lunch) 30/07/2027.

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning panoramic visit of the Three Pyramids of Giza: Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, the most important architectural complex among the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Admire the Sphinx with a human head attributed to King Khafre and a lion's body, and visit the Temple of Khafre. Lunch at a typical restaurant. Afternoon visit to Memphis (open-air museum with colossal statues of Ramses II, a large sphinx, and other archaeological remains). Continue to the Necropolis of Saqqara and its step pyramid (an important cult center with many animal mummies). Highlights include the pyramid designed by Imhotep, the first known architect, for Pharaoh Djoser—a revolutionary design and the first large-scale pyramid). Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.



Day 3 – Cairo / Luxor (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) - 31/07/2027

Breakfast (box). Transfer to Cairo Airport for flight to Luxor. Arrival in Luxor. Visit to Karnak Temple, considered the largest temple in Egypt with its avenue of rams and hall of 132 columns, and Luxor Temple dedicated to the god Amun-Ra, featuring the Avenue of Sphinxes, a 25-meter obelisk, statues of Ramses II, and the Naos. Transfer to the cruise ship and embarkation. Lunch on board. Dinner and overnight on board in Luxor.



Day 4 – Luxor / Esna / Edfu (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) 01/08/2027.

Full board on board. Visit to the Valley of the Kings, tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs when Thebes was Egypt's capital. Visit to the Temple of Hatshepsut. Then, see the Colossi of Memnon—two seated statues of Pharaoh Ramses II, with only fragments of the base and torso remaining, each 17 meters tall. Sail to Esna, pass through the lock. Continue sailing to Edfu. Dinner and overnight on board in Edfu.



Day 5 – Edfu / Kom Ombo / Aswan (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) 02/08/2027. Eclipse Day.

Full board on board. Visit to the Temple of Horus, the best-preserved temple in Egypt and second in importance after Karnak. Notable for its lighting design—rooms become progressively smaller and darker until reaching the sanctuary, illuminated only from the axis.

Sail to Kom Ombo. Visit the temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris. Notable for the relief of medical instruments. Over time, locals disliked being associated with Sobek (a god representing evil), so they added Haroeris as his brother and co-deity. Legend says Sobek plotted against Haroeris, and when the beloved god left, the people followed, leaving the town deserted.

Sail to Aswan. Dinner and overnight on board in Aswan.

Day 6 – Aswan (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) 03/08/2027.

Full board. Visit to the High Dam, once the largest dam in the world, with a body of 3,800 meters and height of 111 meters. Visit to the Unfinished Obelisk, 42 meters tall and weighing 1,176 tons, in the pink granite quarries. Visit to Philae Temple, dedicated to goddess Isis, built during the Greek era and relocated to Egelikia Island to save it from Nile waters after the dam's construction. Felucca ride around Aswan islands. Overnight on board in Aswan



Day 7 – Aswan / Cairo (Breakfast) 04/08/2027.

Disembarkation after breakfast. Free morning with optional excursion to Abu Simbel. At the scheduled time, transfer to Aswan Airport for flight to Cairo. Reception, assistance, and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation in Cairo.



8º Día El Cairo (Desayuno / Almuerzo) 05/08/2027.

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning cultural tour of the city: visit the Citadel of Saladin, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, featuring the Mosque of Muhammad Ali or “Alabaster Mosque,” and the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, home to Tutankhamun’s treasures. Continue to the Coptic Quarter and visit the Church of Saint Sergius, where the Holy Family took refuge. Lunch at a typical restaurant and free time for shopping at the famous Khan el Khalili market. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

Day 8 – Cairo (Breakfast / Lunch) 06/08/2027.

Desayuno en el hotel. Traslado al aeropuerto internacional, salida final.
