

## Itinerario Detallado

### **Day 1 Arrival → Bangkok**

Upon arrival at Bangkok International Airport, you will be warmly greeted by a local and transferred to your hotel for check-in and rest. You will have free time in Thailand's capital, one of the most outstanding cities and a must-see on any Southeast Asian trip.

Suggestion: You could visit ICONSIAM, an impressive riverside shopping mall worth visiting not only for the shopping but also for its spectacular food court, which replicates an indoor floating market, and its terrace overlooking the Chao Phraya River. Overnight in Bangkok.

### **Day 2 Explore the most fun city in Southeast Asia (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Our first stop is the magnificent Grand Palace, a dazzling complex that served as the royal residence from the 18th century until the mid-20th century. This architectural ensemble, with its gleaming golden roofs and intricate details, represents the pinnacle of Thai art and architecture.

In the heart of the Grand Palace grounds, we discover the revered Wat Phra Kaew temple, home to the legendary Emerald Buddha. This extraordinary sacred image, carved from jade during the 15th century, measures just 45 centimeters but radiates a spiritual presence that has captivated devotees and visitors for centuries.

We continue our spiritual journey to Wat Pho, where we come face to face with the breathtaking Reclining Buddha, the largest image of its kind in the country. The intricate details of its gilded surface and the gentle lines of its posture convey a profound sense of serenity.

Our next stop is Wat Trimit pagoda, located in the vibrant Chinatown and considered one of Thailand's most sacred shrines. Its unique architecture and spiritual significance make it a testament to the country's rich cultural heritage.

The tour takes us through bustling Chinatown, the vibrant heart of Bangkok. This labyrinth of alleyways is filled with enticing aromas and overflowing with stalls offering culinary specialties from across Southeast Asia.

We end our day at the majestic Wat Arun, the "Temple of Dawn." Its impressive central tower (prang), the tallest in Bangkok, is exquisitely decorated with Chinese porcelain. The temple's Khmer-style architecture evokes the grand temples of Cambodia, creating a visual link to the ancient architectural traditions of Southeast Asia.

### **Day 3 Bangkok 🚗 Train Market - Damnoen Saduak Floating Market - Bangkok (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Soon, we venture into the magical southwest delta, a lush, green paradise where canals meander through secret gardens of coconut palms and fruit trees. The first stop on our excursion is the Damnoen Saduak Floating Market.

Here, we glide along in a longtail boat, navigating a labyrinth of narrow canals. The air is filled with tantalizing aromas: sweet mangoes on sticky rice and steaming fish ball soups wafting through the humid air. Beyond the bustle of the floating stalls, wooden houses jut out over the canals like silent witnesses to centuries of history.

Our adventure continues to the fascinating Maeklong Railway Market, where time seems to stand still and accelerate to the rhythm of the train. Here, the traders put on a unique spectacle: their stalls rest on the railway tracks until the whistle announces the arrival of the iron giant. Especially, everyone moves in unison, stowing their goods seconds before the train passes, only to return to their places as soon as the tracks are clear.

As night falls, we return to Bangkok.

### **Day 4 Bangkok ➔ Chiang Rai - Golden Triangle - Long-necked Woman Village (B)**

After breakfast, you will have free time at the hotel until your transfer to Bangkok airport for your flight to Chiang Rai in the north of the country.

Upon landing in Chiang Rai, you will be met by our expert local guide who will take you to Mae Sai, a fascinating enclave marking the border between Thailand and Myanmar, representing the northernmost point of the Thai kingdom. This vibrant border market invites you to discover a captivating selection of products from China and Myanmar, offering a unique international trade experience.

Next, we will visit the Karen village, home to the giraffe women tribe. This community, known for its distinctive tradition of elongating their necks with brass rings, keeps its ancestral customs alive. Karen women begin wearing these necklaces from a very young age, adding rings as they grow, creating the illusion of an elongated neck. Their colorful traditional clothing and unique handicrafts offer a fascinating glimpse into their rich cultural heritage. Our journey continues to the legendary Golden Triangle, a mythical crossroads where the borders of Thailand, Laos, and Myanmar meet in a breathtaking confluence. Here, the majestic golden Buddha statue gazes out over the winding waters of the Mekong River, offering a panoramic view that captures the essence of this historic region.

Our next stop takes us to the fascinating Opium Museum, a space that immerses us in the complex historical narratives of the Golden Triangle and its connection to the opium trade. Afterward, we explore the evocative archaeological remains of Chiang Mai, the ancient capital of the Lanna Kingdom, founded around 1328, where every stone whispers tales of a glorious past. At sunset, we return to our comfortable hotel in Chiang Rai to check in and relax.

### **Day 5 Chiang Rai 🚗 White Temple - Blue Temple - Chiang Mai (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

The first stop of the day takes us to the dazzling Blue Temple (Wat Rong Seur Ten), a contemporary masterpiece that emerges like a celestial dream in the Chiang Rai landscape. This sanctuary, conceived by a talented local artist, reinterprets Buddhist philosophy through a modern lens. Its main structure, bathed in a captivating deep blue, merges tradition with a contemporary artistic vision that challenges our perception of sacred architecture.

The journey continues to the enigmatic Black House (Baan Dam Museum), an art complex as fascinating as it is mysterious. This extraordinary museum, the creation of a renowned national artist, unfolds across 32 buildings, primarily Lanna-style pavilions constructed of black wood. Each space houses a unique collection that intertwines surprising elements: from sculptures crafted from horns and bones to reptile skins, traditional African art, ancient boats, and exquisite Lanna handicrafts, creating an intriguing dialogue between the ancient and the contemporary.

We conclude our artistic tour at the iconic White Temple (Wat Rong Khun), an ethereal vision that emerges like a mirage in the landscape. This architectural masterpiece, designed by a renowned national artist, captivates with its gleaming, immaculately white main structure, embellished with crystal fragments that dance in the light, creating a visual spectacle that can be admired from afar.

At sunset, we depart for Chiang Mai to check in and rest.

### **Day 6 Chiang Mai 🚗 City tour - Doi Su Thep Temple (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Our first stop takes us to the majestic Wat Chedi Luang, an impressive structure built in the late 14th century. This magnificent chedi, which once stood as the tallest structure in Chiang Mai, had the honor of housing the revered Emerald Buddha, Thailand's most sacred religious relic.

The spiritual pilgrimage continues to the captivating Wat Phra Singh, erected in 1345. Here, we marvel at the exquisite examples of Lanna art, especially its traditional-style viharn and the finest repository of sacred scriptures in Northern Thailand.

The highlight of our day takes us to the imposing Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, one of the most sacred shrines in Northern Thailand, built in 1383. Located 1,050 meters above sea level, this temple offers a truly sublime experience. We gazed in awe at its dazzling golden chedi, guardian of the sacred relics of Lord Buddha, while reveling in the spectacular panoramic views of Chiang Mai and the Ping Valley that unfolded before us.

For the more adventurous, the approach to the temple offers a mystical journey: 306 steep steps flanked by majestic mythical nagas, symbolizing the spiritual ascent from the earthly world to nirvana.

Overnight in Chiang Mai.

Meal: Breakfast

Dress code: Visitors must be appropriately dressed before being allowed to enter the temple. Men must wear long trousers and shirts with sleeves; sleeveless tops are not permitted. If wearing sandals or flip-flops, socks must be worn (in other words, no bare feet). Women should dress similarly modestly. Transparent clothing, bare shoulders, etc., are not permitted. Bright colors are also discouraged.



### Day 7 Chiang Mai 🚗 Elephant Sanctuary - Chiang Mai (D, L) / Group Tour

Breakfast at the hotel.

In the morning, your local guide will pick you up from your hotel and take you to Chang Chill Elephant Sanctuary, a refuge where elephants live in perfect harmony with nature.

Upon arrival, you'll be immersed in a fascinating presentation that weaves together the past, present, and future of Chang Chill, revealing the unique philosophy that guides this extraordinary sanctuary. Led by local experts, you'll venture into the forest to observe the resident elephants in their natural habitat, grazing and socializing freely. From a safe distance, our guides will share fascinating details about these majestic Asian giants, while you'll learn from the mahouts (caretakers) about their special bond with these animals.

You'll enjoy traditional Thai snacks from an elevated platform, where you can watch the elephants enjoying their mud baths. Later, in the Riverside Hall, you'll participate in preparing their food, filling tubes with corn, sugarcane, and bananas before savoring a Thai vegetarian lunch. Next, in the Traditional Herb Lesson, we explore Chang Chill's fascinating medicinal garden, discovering the healing secrets of plants, leaves, roots, and vines that have served both elephants and humans for generations. We actively participate in harvesting these species, some cultivated and others wild, preparing for our next activity.

The day culminates with a unique Elephant Cooking Class, where we gather in a circle in the riverside room to prepare personalized nutritional supplements for each of the four elephants. The mahouts join us, sharing their knowledge of the health and diet of these magnificent animals, creating a special bond between the visitors and the gentle giants for whom they are "cooking."

At sunset, we begin our return to Chiang Mai.

### Day 8 Chiang Mai → Hanoi (D)

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for your international flight to Hanoi, Vietnam's capital. Upon arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, you will be warmly greeted by a local guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in and rest.

Enjoy some free time to explore the charms of Vietnam's vibrant capital. Hanoi, a must-see gem of Southeast Asia, captivates you with its fascinating blend of ancient tradition and modernity.

Suggestion: Take a stroll down Ta Hien Street, known as Beer Street, and sample the famous local fresh beer while soaking up the lively atmosphere. For dinner, venture out and try Hanoi's famous street food. Pho, Vietnam's iconic noodle soup, is a perfect choice for your first meal in the capital.

### **Day 9 Hanoi, City Sightseeing (D)**

After breakfast at your hotel, we'll head to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, his private residence from 1954 to 1969. Within the complex, we'll visit the One Pillar Pagoda, an important symbol for the people of Hanoi.

The journey continues to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university, built in 1070. Its gardens and well-preserved architecture transport us back in time, revealing the secrets of this ancient land's past.

In the afternoon, we'll visit the majestic Hanoi Cathedral, a medieval Gothic gem, where we'll enjoy a unique experience: savoring traditional lemon tea while observing the lively flow of local life in front of the church.

Afterward, we'll go to the heart of the city, Hoan Kiem Lake. There, you can admire the picturesque Turtle Tower, which stands majestically on its islet, guarding the lake's waters. Ngoc Son Temple, The Huc Bridge, But Thap (Feather Tower), and Dai Nghien (Ink Bowl) weave an architectural symphony that will captivate your senses. As a grand finale, you have the opportunity to delight your palate with a cup of exquisite egg coffee, a unique taste experience.

To conclude your day of exploration in the capital, enjoy a water puppet show, an ancient art form brought to life before your eyes, transporting you to the deepest roots of Vietnamese culture.

### **Day 10 Hanoi 🚗 Sapa: Trekking through the mountain ethnic groups (D)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Your transfer to Sapa begins early with a 5-6 hour drive in a high-quality shared car.

At midday, Sapa welcomes you with its fresh mountain air and panoramic views of the surrounding peaks. After a short break to recharge, you embark on a fascinating cultural adventure.

Our first stop is Lao Chai village, home to 2,000 people living in perfect harmony with nature. The houses, built with local materials such as wood and bamboo, cling to the mountainsides, creating a unique and captivating landscape.

We continue to Ta Van village, home to the Dzay tribe. Here, ancestral traditions come alive before your eyes. Observe the locals going about their daily tasks, perhaps weaving colorful fabrics or working in the rice fields.

At the end of your tour, take some time to refresh yourself before returning to the hotel to check in and rest. The evening is free for you to explore at your own pace, so you can take a stroll through the town of Sapa or discover its local night market.

### **Day 11 Sapa - trek through an ethnic village 🚗 Hanoi (D)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Your adventure begins in Ma Tra village, a hidden paradise nestled among rolling rice paddies. This small village is home to the Black H'mong ethnic minority, known for their artisanal skills and rich cultural heritage.

Next, we continue to Ta Phin village, territory of the Red Dzao ethnic group. The Dzao women, easily recognizable by their colorful red turbans and elaborate embroidered dresses, welcome you with warm smiles.

After your exploration, your vehicle (a 9-seater D-car Limousine bus) will be waiting to take you back to Sapa, where you will have a short rest before beginning your return journey to Hanoi.

### **Day 12 Hanoi 🚗 Halong Bay / Lan Ha - Overnight on a luxury cruise (D, A, C)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

We begin our transfer to the majestic Halong Bay/Lan Ha and board the cruise ship. Upon arrival, you will be greeted with welcome drinks, while the cruise captain provides a detailed introduction to the planned itinerary and the safety measures to follow during the trip.

As the ship sets sail southwest into Lan Ha or Ha Long Bay, you can enjoy a delicious lunch on board, all while marveling at the breathtaking views this famous destination offers.

In the afternoon, the cruise makes stops at various points of interest within the bay, allowing you to participate in scheduled excursions, which may include island explorations, caves, or water activities. Upon returning to the cruise ship, you have the opportunity to join an entertaining cooking class, where you can demonstrate your culinary skills. Meanwhile, you can admire the sunset over the serene bay from the cruise ship's deck—a moment that promises to be unforgettable. As night approaches, the ship anchors in a safe spot, and you'll enjoy a special set-menu dinner while the cruise manager briefs you on the next day's activities. After dinner, you can retire to your cabin to rest, or if you prefer, join the staff for a nighttime squid fishing activity—a unique experience that allows you to connect even more deeply with the marine environment.

### **Day 13 Halong Bay / Lan Ha 🚗 Hanoi → Flight to Hue (D, Brunch)**

Begin your day with a Tai Chi class on the ship's sundeck, where you can enjoy complimentary tea and coffee. The gentle, flowing movements of Tai Chi, performed at sunrise over the bay, allow you to relax both your body and mind while taking in the breathtaking scenery. Shortly after, a light breakfast is served on board, offering a leisurely meal while continuing to admire the views.

Take your time to enjoy the activities available on the ship, whether exploring the last stops or simply relaxing on deck. Before checking out, enjoy a delicious brunch on board, where you can savor a final meal as the cruise begins its return to port. Finally, we disembark the ship and begin our return journey to Hanoi to catch our domestic flight to the next destination on our trip, Hue.

Upon arrival, you will be met by our driver and transferred to your hotel to check in and rest.

### **Day 14 Hue, visit to the imperial citadel(D)**

After breakfast, we begin our day with a visit to the majestic Imperial Citadel. This walled fortress, conceived as a reflection of Beijing's Forbidden City, will transport you to the golden age of the Vietnamese emperors. Pass through the imposing Ngo Mon Gate and enter the mysterious Purple Forbidden City, once reserved exclusively for the Nguyen royal family. Although much of its splendor was devastated during the bombings of 1968, the ruins retain an aura of grandeur that speaks of centuries of history.

The next stop on the tour is Thien Mu Pagoda, one of the oldest pagodas in Hue. Built in the 17th century, this pagoda not only offers a breathtaking panoramic view of the city but also a deep dive into the history, culture, and spirituality of Vietnam.

The afternoon takes us to the Tomb of King Minh Mang, the second emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty, who reigned from 1820 to 1840. He was one of the Nguyen Dynasty's exceptional emperors, implementing unique economic, cultural, and educational policies and reforms. This mausoleum is a testament to the fusion of classical royal architecture and Western influences.

Our final stop of the day is the Tomb of Khai Dinh, the last feudal dynasty of Vietnam. Boasting a magnificent blend of European and Asian classical architectural styles, the Khai Dinh Mausoleum impresses many visitors.

### **Day 15 Hue 🚗 Danang - Hoi An (D)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

In the morning, we embark on a fascinating journey along the scenic coastal road to Hoi An, about 130 km south of Hue. This route, considered one of the most picturesque in Vietnam, will reward you with panoramic views that will be etched in your memory.

Along the way, we admire the Pass of the Clouds (Hai Van Pass) as it winds between mist-shrouded mountains and the shimmering South China Sea before arriving in Da Nang. We then travel to Hoi An and check into our hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore the city at your own pace.

Suggestion: Participate in a local cooking class to learn how to prepare traditional Vietnamese dishes. As the sun begins to set, you can take a boat trip on the Thu Bon River, watching the city come alive in the twilight.

### **Day 16 Hoi An, city tour(D)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Start your day in the heart of Hoi An, an architectural gem that seems frozen in time. Our first stop is the iconic Japanese Bridge, a 400-year-old structure dating back to 1590, where merchants and travelers have crossed for centuries.

Continue your walk to Phung Hung House, a living testament to the fusion of Vietnamese, Japanese, and Chinese architectural styles. Afterward, we head to Phuc Kien Assembly Hall, a building renowned for its vibrant colors and cultural significance. Dedicated to Thien Hau, the patron goddess of sailors, this hall is a reminder of Hoi An's deep connection to the sea.

As you wander through the cobblestone streets, you'll find yourself surrounded by art galleries and tailor shops. Hoi An is famous for its bespoke clothing, so if you wish, you can take home a truly unique and personalized souvenir.

In the afternoon, we travel to the picturesque fishing village of Cam Thanh. Here, traditional Vietnam comes alive before your eyes, offering a unique glimpse into the daily lives of local families.

We board a bamboo basket boat on the waters of Cam Thanh, where we'll receive a brief explanation of its history. Afterward, you'll have the opportunity to become a fisherman for a day, learning ancestral techniques of fishing with round and gillnets. The challenge culminates with a rowing lesson in these curious basket boats, navigating through the serene coconut groves that line the river.

### Day 17 Hoi An 🚗 Bana Hills - Golden Bridge → Flight to Siem Reap (D)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Afterwards, our guide will pick you up and transfer you to Ba Na Hills. The ascent on the ultramodern cable car system offers a unique experience, floating among the clouds while contemplating a spectacular panorama of the Vietnamese landscape. The route takes us through old French villages until we reach the mountain peak at 1,487 meters, passing through Nui Chua and several suspension bridges.

A highlight is the visit to the famous Golden Bridge, an architectural masterpiece that has become an icon of the region. At Vong Nguyet Village, we explore its historic winery and marvel at the majestic Linh Ung Pagoda, where the monument to Sakyamuni Buddha welcomes us with its serene presence.

Next, we take a tour of Da Nang before transferring to the airport for our flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. Upon arrival, we will transfer directly to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free for you to explore the city.

Suggestion: You can relax at the nearby spas that offer traditional Khmer massages. You could also visit the old city center, such as Pub Street. It's bustling with bars, restaurants, and street stalls where you can sample delicious Cambodian cuisine.

### Day 18 Siem Reap - Sunrise Tuk Tuk Ride 🚗 Angkor Wat - Ta Prohm - Angkor Thom (D)

Early in the morning, we embark on a magical tuk-tuk adventure to witness the sunrise over the ancient temples. Afterward, we return to the hotel for breakfast, preparing for today's journey.

Our exploration begins in the majestic Angkor Thom, the 12th-century capital, passing through its imposing South Gate, flanked by colossal statues that tell the story of the churning of the ocean of milk. In its heart, we discover the enigmatic Bayon Temple, where 54 towers gaze down upon us with more than 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara. The tour continues through the mysterious Phimeanakas, the majestic Royal Precinct, and the spectacular Terraces of the Elephants and the Leper King.

The morning culminates at Ta Prohm, where nature and architecture wage an eternal battle for dominance. Enormous roots of centuries-old trees embrace the ancient stones like giant tentacles, creating a mysterious and captivating scene. In the afternoon, we venture into the crown jewel: Angkor Wat. This colossal 81-hectare complex, the emblem of the Cambodian flag, represents the pinnacle of 12th-century Khmer art and architecture, rivaling the Imperial Palace in Beijing in magnificence. Its five iconic towers reach for the sky like stone fingers reaching for the divine. We explore its sumptuous courtyards and climb its walls, marveling at the mastery of the artisans who carved the epic Ramayana into stone.

As the sun begins its descent, we ascend Bakheng Hill to witness a sunset fit for the gods. The last golden rays reflect off the towers of Angkor Wat, bathing the entire landscape in a magical light that seems to suspend time.

### **Day 19 Siem Reap 🚗 Tonle Sap Lake - Banteay Samre - Banteay Srei - Grand Circuit (D)**

After breakfast, we set off for the majestic Tonle Sap, a freshwater giant that pulses with the seasons. In the village of Kampong Pluck, we boarded a private boat that took us into a world where water dictates every aspect of daily life.

Houses on stilts rise from the water like delicate herons, while families go about their daily lives—fishing, teaching, and selling their wares—several meters above the lake's surface. The lake is a living organism that provides sustenance for thousands of families, keeping alive centuries-old traditions that adapt to the rhythm of the waters.

In the afternoon, our journey takes us through the Cambodian countryside to the exquisite Banteay Srei Temple, known as the "Citadel of Women" for the delicacy of its carvings. This small pink sandstone temple is considered the most precious jewel of Khmer art. Its reliefs, carved with a precision that seems to defy the possibilities of stone, narrate ancient stories from the Ramayana and the Mahabharata.

The exploration continues at Banteay Samre, a temple that seems to have sprung from a fairy tale with its perfect symmetry and exceptional state of preservation. Built in the 12th century, this sanctuary offers a unique glimpse into Khmer architecture at its finest.
